6. CATERING

a) Social Functions

Catering and refreshments will be available at the member's expense.

b) Competition Days

Breakfast will be provided to officials at the officials briefing area at Scarborough SLSC from 6am daily.

As per previous years, daily lunches and on beach drinks will be provided for officials involved on competition days (Tue, Wed, Thurs, Fri, Sat & Sun). These will be distributed under the direction of the Sectional Referees. At the completion of activities on these days, refreshments will be available at the officials briefing area at Scarborough SLSC. SLSA wishes to invite the partners of officials to the debrief if they wish to attend.

7. DRESS OF OFFICIALS

It is imperative that the appearance of appointed officials for the Australian Championships and Australian Masters Championships is of a standard befitting the event. (Surf Sports Manual 32nd Edition, Clause 13.4)

Therefore, appointed officials are requested to give detailed attention to their appearance. Dress shall be neat white shorts / skirt **or** optional navy blue shorts / skirt with the white shirt / championships shirts that is distributed at the event.

NOTE: Each official will be given two officials shirts which must be worn on the Saturday / Sunday. Officials who are officiating for 2 days or less will receive ONE official's shirt.

ONLY PLAIN WHITE OF THE 2007 OFFICIALS SHIRTS ARE PERMITTED TO BE WORN AT THE 2007 AUSTRALIAN AND MASTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS.

A dress shirt will also be presented to each official to recognise their important contribution to SLSA. Officials are encouraged to wear this shirt at social functions (in particular the Officials Dinner on Saturday), but not on the competition arena. A hat and sponsor spray jacket will also be provided.

NOTE: SLSA would like to remind all officials to bring a refillable water bottle that they can refill throughout the championships with water that will be made available.

Head gear can be either a white hat or cap or the event cap which will be provided at the event.

NOTE: No sponsor or other identification other than the SLSA logo are permitted on any officials clothing, hats, etc. Notwithstanding the foregoing, sponsored shirts etc, maybe made available for issue to carnival officials who will be expected to wear these garments generally, Sunday in particular.



8. MULTIPLE DUTIES OF OFFICIALS

Depending on resource needs some officials may be requested to work in positions or areas other than those listed in this bulletin. Such officials will be advised during the course of competition.

Any official from areas finishing early and not otherwise advised, may contact Gordon McNaughton in the administration areas for listing for further allocation if required.

9. APPOINTMENTS

The appointment of officials is a consultative process involving the Director of Surf Sports and the Competition Officials Advisor, and when appointed the area Referees. All appointments emanate from nominations received and endorsed by the respective Branches, States and National bodies. These appointments are based upon officials' competencies as assessed periodically.

10. HEALTH AND FITNESS OF OFFICIALS

Each and every appointed official is encouraged to prepare for these championships by ensuring that they are in a physical condition that will allow them to work in prevailing conditions in a comfortable manner. It cannot be over-stressed that to officiate at these particular Australian Championships over the 5-6 day period, requires quite an amount of physical and mental effort.

Further, each official is strongly encouraged to undertake an examination, under the supervision of a medical practitioner, to ensure their physical condition is of a level that will allow them to carry out their appointed duties.

After advice received from the Cancer Council, it is stressed that all officials be adequately protected from the sun to avoid over exposure. The wearing of appropriate officials clothing and white caps and/or hats plus the application of recognised sun protection creams and lotions is strongly advised.

11. NAME BARS

All officials are advised that it is essential that they bring their national officials accredited name bars and license. Additional to this each official will be issued with a photo ID tag upon prior to competition.

12. REFEREE'S CLOTHING

Area and sectional referees will be supplied with coloured bibs to be worn over their white shirts. This will allow all area and sectional referees to be identified to their position.

13. COLLECTION OF OFFICIALS EQUIPMENT

Each appointed officials must present themselves at the officials briefing area at Scarboro SLSC to collect their Officials Kit between the following times:

ID tags will be produced distributed to officials in Officials Kit. Those officials who do not have an official ID tag in their Officials Kit *must report to the Officials briefing area at Scarborough SLSC* where they will be issued with an ID tag prior to competition.

14. THE FINALS ARENA

It is accepted practice that not all appointed officials will officiate on the final day of competition. The Referee in consultation with the Director of Surf Sports, Area Referees and the Competition Officials Advisor will appoint the finals panel.
